Verguet's Sketchbook

A Marist Missionary Artist in 1840s Oceania: Father Léopold Verguet (1817-1914), was a Marist missionary and part of the first Christian mission to the Solomon Islands in 1845. He was a terrific artist who used pencil and watercolours to record the places and faces he encountered. He painted birds, flowers, artworks, artefacts and people. His sketchbook is preserved in the archives of the Society of Mary General House in Rome. To commemorate the centenary of the death of Fr Verguet, a beautifully illustrated volume has been published by Frs Mervyn Duffy (NZ) and Alois Greiler, the German regional superior. They hope to open up this treasure of the Pacific mission to a broad readership. The volume is dominated by these extraordinary images of first contact, plus extracts from primary sources, the letters of Verguet and his confrères. Summer camp from the Spanish Region at Monteverde Rome, August 2nd to 14th

A group of 19 young people from Spain aged from 17- 19, set up camp in the gardens of the General House. They were accompanied by Dani Argibay, a lay Marist, and Fr Toño Fernández (Esp). They spent the mornings visiting the typical sites of Rome and the general houses of the Marist and SMSM Sisters, although they considered themselves pilgrims rather than tourists. They also had two opportunities to listen to Pope Francis. In the evenings they held sessions of Christian and Marist formation with a



clear vocational orientation: Finding your place in the Church and in the Marist family. The experience was very positive and they received an excellent welcome from the communities of Monteverde and the sisters. Plans already exits to repeat the experience as soon as possible!
