Timor Leste 'Dying at Home' with care & compassion A Training program in Tetum language for village health workers

A STORY OF THE HEART by Dr. Helen-Anne Manion OAM

"In 2002 I met with Maria Dias, Founder Director of PAS Clinic in Dili, Timor Leste, and heard a tragic story of her dying brother in hospital, crying out in vain to go home to die in his village with family. When we told her about our Dying At Home Program she said, "I must bring this to my people". Dying At Home Program was established in 1980 by Gerard Manion and me, a unique program teaching best care of dying loved ones to empower families, their friends and neighbours to do this precious work of love. A program with profound effects, especially building compassion and loving care skills".





Our dream was realized in October 2016 with our first training program in Dili, with all teaching materials translated into Tetum, training 46 enthusiastic, dedicated Leaders who grasped their mission to families in their communities, to build a new culture of care for the dying person and

family. They go forth to establish Dying At Home Program for families in their own villages and towns.

Maria's goal is to establish Dying At Home Program in many districts.
