SAINT PEDRO CHANEL SCHOOL, MALGRAT DE MAR, SPAIN, 15 DECEMBER

The only Marist Fathers school in Spain has been formally transferred to the Marist Brothers by way of the *Fundació Champagnat* in Catalonia. The transfer will be implemented gradually during the present school year. During a ceremony on 15 December, the new association was presented to the current school administration, the staff and the school council. The Provincial superior of L'Hermitage, Br Pere Ferré, the members of his council and the 4 members of the Board of Management



explained how they are organised in Catalonia and France, and described the network of 9 schools and 15 social projects they manage through the Foundation. The Province of Europe was present at this important moment by Jean-Marie Bloqueau (Fr), the vicar provincial, Joaquín Fernández (Esp), the provincial bursar, and by Fr Angel Antón, legal representative in Spain. Of course, members of the local community working in the school were there too. The future of the school is very promising.

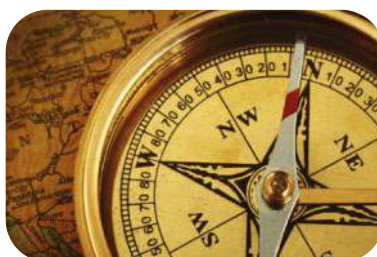
GREETINGS FROM PARIS!

CENTRE CULTUREL ET SPIRITUEL MARISTE (CCSM), TOULON, FRANCE, 3 DECEMBER



170 years ago, a group of young Marist missionaries led by Bishop Douarre arrived in the southern port of Toulon to sail to New Caledonia. While waiting to depart, they made valuable contacts with local people. It was the beginning of a significant Marist presence in the centre of that city. Today, *La Residence*, rue Clappier continues this presence. The chapel welcomes the public every day, people seeking a time of quiet meditation or seeking a listening ear. In 2014 a group composed of lay people and Marist Fathers, was established to think about the future and to develop a city-centre church devoted to the evangelisation of those on its threshold and those at the periphery. This project supported by both lay and religious, became the CCSM (Marist Cultural and Spiritual Centre). It held its first general assembly and 40 people attended. An animation team of 7 people assures the program of activities: biblical and theological formation, meditation and spiritual life, art and spirituality, social issues, ecumenical and interreligious encounters.
