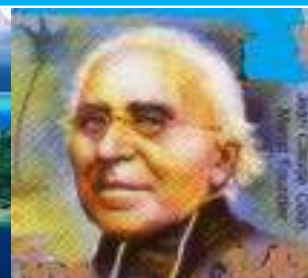

For Reflection...

Provincial Chapter 2017 Statute #128 "A Sector is a part of the Oceania Marist Province normally with geographical, cultural or political unity." The Statute goes on to mention the following terms: SECTOR OF THE PROVINCE; SECTOR DELEGATE; SECTOR BURSAR; VICAR DELEGATE, etc...

Bishop Peter in his homily stressed the Priesthood of Christ which we all share and called for faithfulness that call. Fr. James Ross sm gave an inspiring homily in Fr Mikaele's first Mass. Jim emphasized how lay people appreciate the gift of the priest who journey with them in faith. Fr Mikaele will continue working at Mt St Mary's parish in Nadi for the rest of 2018.
