FAREWELL OF THE MARISTS IN ROTUMA



In July in the Province of Oceania our confreres were farewelled by the local community

as they handed over the responsibility of the Lady of Victories Church in Rotuma, Fiji, to the Archdiocese of Fiji. The Marist Mission in Rotuma began in 1846 when the French missionaries arrived in Fiji. Since then, during 174 years, many Marists have ministered in Rotuma, and made a significant contribution to the Catholic Church on the island. The transition was marked with a solemn mass, during which the vicar provincial, Fr Milikiade Rayalu sm handed over the key of the church to the vicar general of the Archdiocese.

New Seminarists Welcomed in Rome

The International Theologate welcomed this week two new first year students, Clinton Kube (Cameroon) and Carlos Olivares Flores (Mexico). The students have arrived in Rome a bit later than usual.
