SENEGAL VISITATION

Recently Fr Ben McKenna, who is the link person for the District of Africa, visited the community in Dakar, Senegal. The five confreres of the community take care of the following ministries:

- The Parish of St Josephine Bakhita, Hann, Dakar, serving three pastoral areas, and in a process of the building of a new Parish Church
- The Marist school "Cours Sainte Marie" at Hann, with ca. 2.000 students, from kindergarten to high school and which is now under Diocesan Administration.
- The "Colin School" in Ndiakhirate, opened by the District in 2017 and which is under ongoing development
- The Kër Nazareth Centre for street children in Dakar, ministered in collaboration with the SMSM sisters and Marist Laity. Amongst other things the centre provides food, clothes and medical care for street children and works for the reintegration in their families when possible.
