## The Dignity of the Person and Human Development

Pope Francis sent a message to the world leaders gathered for the World Economic Conference in Davos, Geneva in January this year calling on the world leaders: 'to safeguard the dignity of the human person, in particular by offering to all people real opportunities for integral human development'.

Pope Francis stated that: "men and women risk being reduced to mere cogs in a machine that treats them as items of consumption to be exploited, with the result that – as is so tragically apparent – whenever a human life no longer proves useful for that machine, it is discarded with few qualms".

The stories in this Newsletter are wonderful examples of safeguarding human dignity and fostering integral human development with a deep spirit of compassion and justice. The program in Bangladesh for children with disabilities is called: Anondo Neer, meaning 'Nest Joy'.

The families who bring their children to the centre learn the skills to help with their child's development. Not only are the children benefiting from the physical therapy given, the mothers are also finding much support and joy in being together.
