This year, one of our Marists celebrating a special anniversary is Br. Leonard Haley SM of the Isabella Street Community in Boston. He will mark his 60th anniversary of Marist profession; he was professed on December 8th, 1959 in Staten Island, New York. He has served as a Marist in various ministries in several locations, which include Notre Dame High School in Harper Woods, Michigan, St. Anne's Parish in Lawrence, Massachusetts and the former Marist Community at 27 Isabella Street in Boston.

The Cardinal reflected on the celebration in his weekly blog and ended by saying: "Brother Leonard said that he was with me 10 years ago when he was celebrating his Golden Jubilee and so I told him that I expect him to come back in 10 years for his 70th!"
