# PENTECOST WEEKEND WITH THE LAY MARIST AND JOHN LARSEN IN LA NEYLIÈRE

The French Lay Marists gathered at La Neylière over the Pentecost weekend with John Larsen, Superior General of the Marist Fathers, who shared his reflections on the theme 'Nothing is impossible with God: do you believe it?' (Luke 1:37). (Attached the <u>French</u> and <u>English</u> text).

He reminded us that Mary was called by her name and given a role in the history of salvation, and how this can challenge us in our lives as Marists and lay people to respond to the call that the Lord addresses to us.

Mary is a missionary of joy (Luke 1: 39-56) and he also mentioned the missionary zeal of lay Marists like Françoise Perroton and Suzanne Aubert. 'There are still lay Marists who offer part of their lives to go abroad to distant Marist missions and bring the Good News to the people there. This movement of lay Marists on mission is very useful, especially for young people or sometimes for retired lay Marists.'

Among the activities offered were a bibliodrama, a visit to the two museums, meditation in the oratory in front of the mural, and the renewal of vows for the members of the association at the 11 a.m. Mass celebrated by John Larsen on Sunday with the local community of La Neyliere.

This was followed by the general assembly meeting and the election of a new board with Odile de Villenaut as president replacing Bernard Fenet, Anne Busseti as treasurer, and Marie-Claude Grulier remaining as secretary.

#### NATIONAL ADMINISTRATORS AND BURSARS MEETING IN PARIS

This meeting was held in Paris on 11th June with the provincial finance administration. Each country was represented by its national administrator and national bursar. This year the meeting was only one day long. Each country gave a detailed account of its financial situation and which actions they were planning to adopt in the coming year. The central purpose of the meeting is to foster the financial unity of the province or to build up the WE of the province by the sharing of information from each Unit.

The provincial bursar gave an input on succession planning in the financial area and on the directions, we should take in the next number of years. Cora Dubruque-Cantù, our financial administration manager gave a detailed presentation of the accounts of the UESM. Pat Brophy represented the General Administration as Bursar along with Giovanni Maria Manozzi and spoke about the development projects the GA were funding in Marist mission areas. He also thanked the province for its generosity to the global SM.

Some of the evaluation forms suggested that for next year we should include some small group work to look concretely at what we need to plan and achieve over the next few years.
