This year, the annual program of Marist Studies “Marist Studies Summer Program” will be held in Rome at Casa di Maria from 8 July until 2 August. The program will be attended by some of our student priests in Rome, but is open to other professed confreres as well as to members of the other branches of the Marist Family and lay people who are committed to the Marist project (e.g. teachers, archivists etc.). The program’s goals are:

- to broaden the exposure of participants to the world of our Colnian Marist charism and spirit;
- to produce some material, in a variety of formats, on ‘things Marist’ for the wider Society;
- to promote Marist Studies and to ask participants to present to the wider world the fruit of their study. A hope would also be to discover confreres who have the desire and the capacity to carry this discipline forward in the Society.

During the program there will be input from some speakers and a visit to the General Archives. It will be possible to visit the Colin Places in Rome. However the focus will be on individual guided reading and research, by each participant, in accord with this or her best interest and ability.
